HHSC is pleased to share with you additional information and documents related to the planned ATLIS program. HHSC shared these materials with CMS last week, with Medicaid managed care organizations (MCOs) last night, and anticipates finalizing them for inclusion in the UMCC and UCMC later this month. HHSC is not distributing the UMCC language to anyone other than the MCOs; however, MCOs may distribute the language to associations, providers, or others at their prerogative.
